Membership Types

Plan Sponsor Membership is open to all individuals who are currently serving as a director, trustee or staff member of a public retirement system.

Individual membership rate as a Plan Sponsor member is \$25.00. The organizational rate as a Plan Sponsor member is \$100.00 for the first five (5) individuals and \$20.00 for each additional individual within the organization.

Emeritus Membership is open to individuals who, except for retirement, would qualify as Plan Sponsor members. They cannot be employed with an entity serving the retirement community such as an actuarial, consulting, custodial, legal, plan administration or investment firm.

Individual membership for an Emeritus member is \$15.00.

Affiliate Membership is open to individuals who have expressed an interest in the Association and its mission, but who do not fall within the definition of Plan Sponsor or Emeritus memberships. Individuals with actuarial, consulting, custodial, legal, plan administration and investment firms would be considered Affiliate members.

Individual membership for an Affiliate member is \$600.00.
